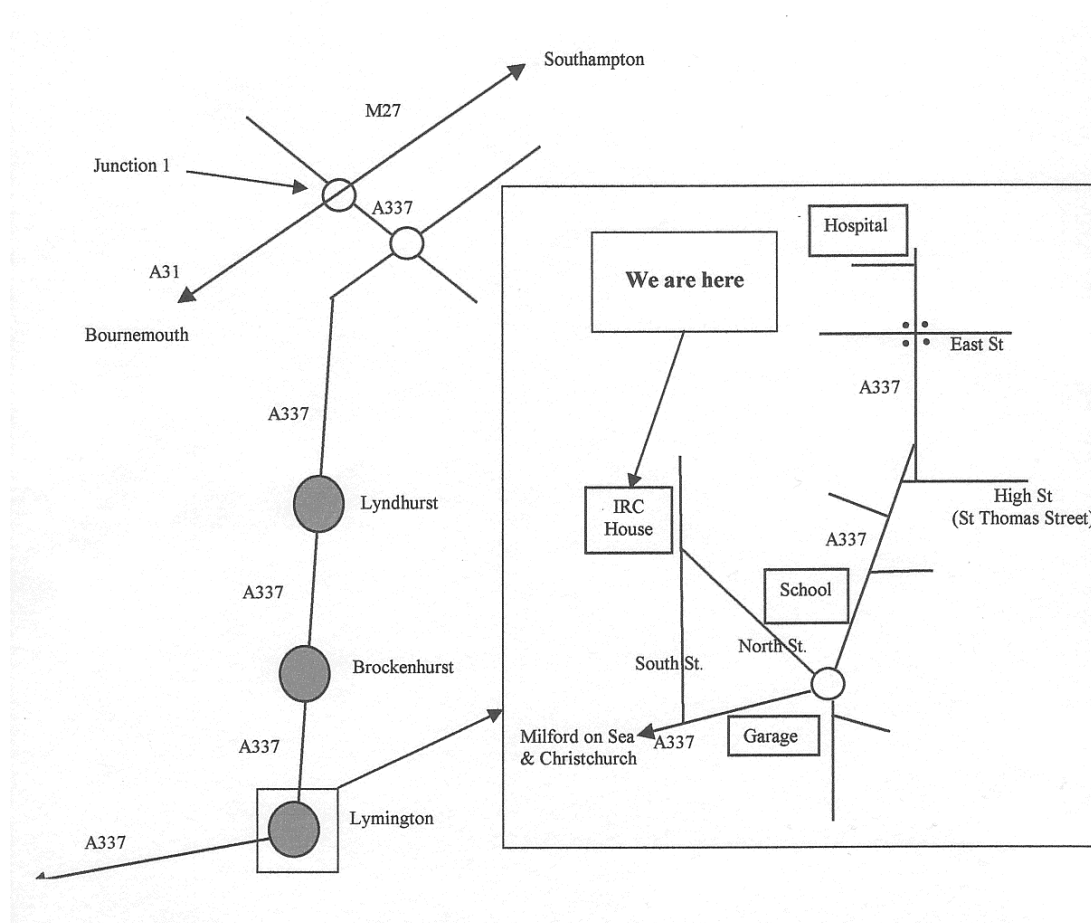

How to find Piscis Conservation at IRC House:

In Lymington, follow the A337, signposted to Milford-on-Sea and Christchurch; bear right in the small one-way system at the top of the High Street and after the corner immediately join the left-hand lane. After ¼ mile there is a pale green pub called the White Hart on the left. At the roundabout, take the 3rd exit (hard right) in to North St. Go past the School, to the end of North St, past the Musketeer pub. At the junction, IRC House is the white building with green arched windows on the opposite side of the road. Parking is available either on the forecourt or in the Church Hall car park at the rear of the building.

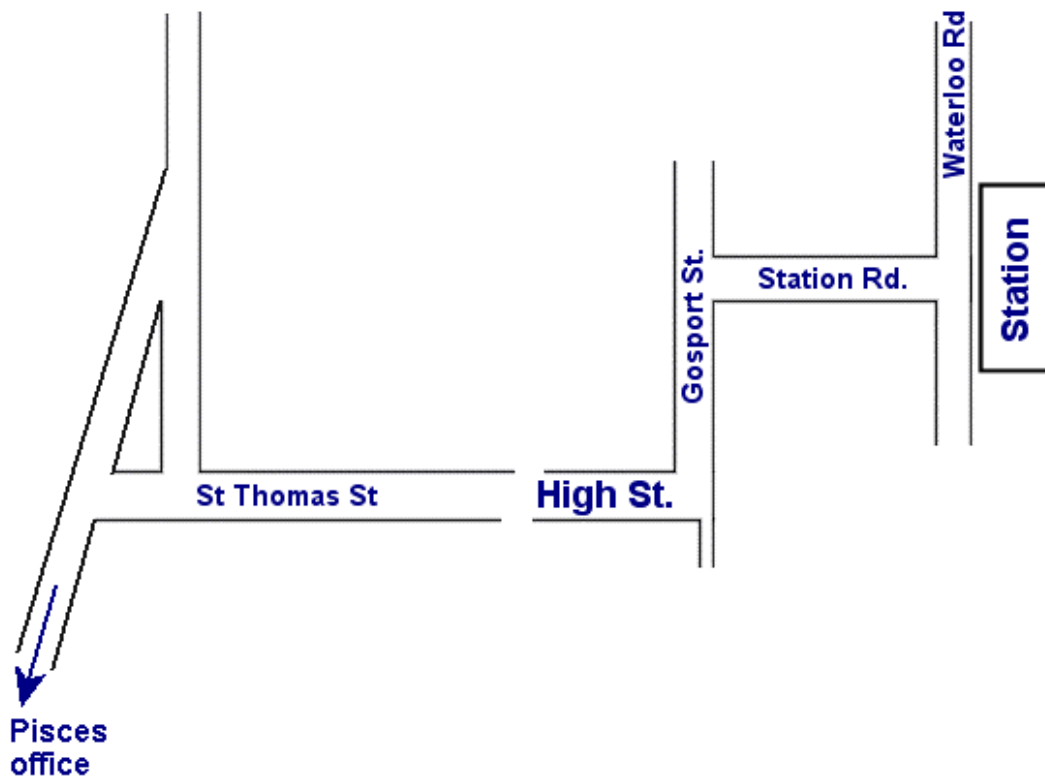

From Lymington rail station, go up the road from the station, turn left at the junction, and then bear right up the High Street. High Street becomes St Thomas Street at the top end, past the church.



St Thomas St meets the one-way system; bear left along the A337 signposted to Milford-on-Sea/Christchurch, then follow the directions above for the Pisces Office. From the station it is approximately 10 minutes' walk to the B&B, 20 minutes to Pisces.

Obviously the New Forest is worth a visit if you're planning to stay an extra day or so; there are buses, or you can even hire cycles from New Forest Cycle Experience in Brockenhurst. A search for new+forest at www.google.com will no doubt reveal much information.

As for food, the High Street is pretty full of possibilities, with many hotels, restaurants and pubs. Personally recommended are:
The Fusion Inn (in the one-way system at the very top of the High St/St Thomas St), for Thai and far eastern food,
Ask, for pizza/pasta (top of High St, opposite main Post Office),
Lal Quilla, for curry, and the
King's Head, (both at the bottom end of High St), for seafood, steaks and general good food.
The King's Head is a good place for beer, too, and may offer accommodation.
